New Scandinavia Lutheran Church celebrated their first program on Sunday January 15 after their service. After the church burned in 2010, members stepped forward to rebuild the church. Their excellent work meant that the insurance money went farther than was planned. With prayerful thought and planning the money was invested. The members again decided that this money was not donated and was not earned, so they decided to share the money with the charities that our members worked with or donated to. A committee decided who received the money.



Each charity was encouraged to come to the banquet to explain how they would use the money and to receive their checks. The following were the charities that would receive this money: The Honduras Well Project, Pioneer Museum Children's project, Nature's Edge Therapy, LMC Hospice patient fund as well as buying Bibles for their patients. Others

receiving include Little Red Barn Rescue, ADRC Daybreak and Transportation, Beds 4 Kids, Chetek We Care fund, Barron AM Legion and VFW. Peppy Pals 4H club received funds to purchase craft supplies for the people at Pioneer Nursing Home. ELCA mission projects were helped with the purchase of stamps, baby clothing, quilt supplies and school supplies. St. Jude was also awarded monies. A total of \$ 27,000 was awarded.




Welcome to worship.
