Report of the Synod Assembly of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin

The voting delegates of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin gathered at Bethany Lutheran Church on Saturday, April 26, 2025 to make decisions about the ministries happening within the synod and the work of the greater church.

The gathering began with a "Holy Humor" worship service with Holy Communion under the theme of "Come and See" and Bishop Martin used John 1:43-51 as the starting point for his sermon and the theme for the gathering. The prayers of intercession were compiled using the words of the Sunday School students of United Lutheran.

We saw a video from Presiding Bishop, Elizabeth Eaton and given a Churchwide greeting from Churchwide Representative, Imran Siddiqui, Vice President of the ELCA. We heard about the decisions that need to be made at the Churchwide level over what to do with decreasing benevolence and recognizing they understand that is because of smaller offerings at the congregation level. We then heard the organizations supported by the ELCA and what it means that fewer dollars are going to these organizations.

A resolution was submitted and approved that the synod would be conducting a three year "Love Your Neighbor" Capital Campaign with the goal of raising \$175,000 for the support and sustainability of the Neighbor 2 Neighbor ministry, created and run by Deacan Lidixe Montoya, that builds connections between the synod and the Hispanic community within the synod including but not limited to Eau Claire.

A resolution was submitted and approved that the Synod will make every effort to translate key documents and provide interpretation for events and experience in both English and Spanish, as a way to more fully connect with our Spanish-speaking neighbors. Furthermore, the costs for translation and interpretation services will be covered for two years through a grant received from the ELCA.

After much discussion, a resolution was submitted and approved to accept the 2026 Minimum Standards for Compensation and Benefits that was approved by the Synod Council.

This led to the resolution submitted and approved for the Operating Mission Plan recommended by the Synod Council.

The final resolution submitted and approved was called "National Day of Remembrance for Indian Boarding Schools. This will be memorialized at the 2025 Churchwide Assembly to address the legacies of our church's role in Indian Boarding Schools. Including but not limited to each congregation commemorate the day annually on or near September 30th, and encouraging ministries to commit to learning the truth of their involvement with Indian boarding schools and to responsibly create paths to healing and repair.

The synod also received reports from the following ministries operating within our synod; Lutheran Social Services (LSS), Campus Ministry, and Portico (benefit provider for those called to serve). We received the Bishop's report, elected new Synod Council members, elected people to the Discipline Committee, and recognized those council members that have completed their time. We remembered those who passed away this last year, including SAM John Kurschner of Chetek and we celebrated those who have reached milestone Anniversary and those who have retired.

The Assembly with closing prayers and we were on our way at 3pm.

A big thank you to Carol Abbuehl, Addyson Micheels, Tom Ebler Jr, and Marion Wigen for you willingness to be representatives for our congregations and for being leaders in our congregations.
