Treasurer's report -

\$1,600 in the red this month, with \$1,200 worth of bills. Money moved from CD, took a \$800 reduction due to restarting the CD. Propane contract is \$1.59/gallon through Synergy, and have a credit from last year of \$2,300. We purchase 2,700 gallons annually.

Pastor's report -

Our Synod's Director of Evangelical Mission Reverend Diane House will preach at our 150th anniversary celebration. VBS is being offered at ULC on Wednesdays in August from 6:00 - 7:30 pm. Memorial service for Clarence Wicken will take place on Saturday, August 23 at 11 am, visitation at 9 am at the church. August 24-26 is the Fall Theological Conference in Hudson, WI. After the conference, Pastor will be on vacation until Sept 1 or 2. Addyson Michels will lead worship that Sunday.

Deacon Ministries – Anniversary check received from Gloria Vreeland - \$150 for quilting & \$150 for Sunday school.

Trustee Ministries – Need to rebuild the retaining wall, Tom still plans to touch base with Charlie Rihn. Dave & Robert pressure washed the church siding on Thurs 7/17. While pressure washing, they found several holes in siding due to rock damage during mowing. Cemetery committee member will be encouraged to discuss this with Tom who does the mowing. Sealcoating of parking lot has been completed by Superior Sealers. Dave is trying to track down letters for marquee sign, will call. Bob will consult with Jim Cimfl to see if he will volunteer his backhoe & time to assist with repairing the retaining wall.

Children Youth and Family Ministries – Kristal plans to remain with the existing curriculum that goes on a 3-year cycle. She ordered the Christmas program. Confirmation is right around the corner.

Old Business – Shelly advised the t-shirt order must be placed by mid-September. Minimum order of 50 shirts for \$946.76. Will have a sign-up sheet at church and make a post to Facebook to determine order. Lenore Robinson has offered to decorate the tables with wildflowers and provide the tablecloths for the 150th anniversary, but is requesting \$200 reimbursement. This was tabled for now, Tom will visit further with Lenore. Pastors Ralph & Ron have RSVP'd for the celebration. Last month, Council discussed WELCA's request for funds to replace the coffee maker, a motion was made to limit the funds to \$250. **M/S/C** – Kristal/Sue. However, in the meantime, Tom found a company out of Eau Claire to service the existing coffee maker; it needed a good cleaning. Therefore, a replacement is no longer needed.

New Business – Labor Day parade in Ridgeland, lineup is 10:30 - 12:30. Parade starts at 1:00. Michelle is organizing the parade and will provide our float number ahead of time. Louise provided wooden nickels, some will be put in a bowl for the 150^{th} and some will be handed out at the parade. Husets provided a framed photo for consideration to be hung in fellowship hall. M/S/C – Kristal/Shelly approved hanging on north wall. September noisy offering will be donated to Barron & Chetek school district's backpack programs – M/S/C – Michelle/Kristal. October & November noisy offering will be donated to Adopt-a-Family; Chetek Police Dept has provided 2 families, and we will consider more families if others are provided. M/S/C – Dawn/Michelle. Prayer box out front to be removed and filled in with dirt. M/S/C – Dawn/Shelly



5th and 6th Grade: The Lord's Prayer, The Apostle's Creed, The Commandments 1-10, Psalm 23, John 3:16, Matthew 22:37-39, John 14:6, Matthew 7:7, Matthew 7:12, The Beatitudes Matthew 5:3-12, Isaiah 40:3,5, Matthew 7:1-2, Matthew 5:43-44, 1 John 1:7, Matthew 28:19-20.

7th and 8th Grade: The Lord's Prayer, The Apostle's Creed, The Commandments 1-10, Psalm 23, The Beatitudes Matthew 5:3-12, Ephesians 2:8-9, Matthew 18:20, John 11:25-26, Matthew 25:40, Matthew 6:19-21, Mark 9:23b, Psalm 100, Roman 3:28, John 8:31b, 32, 1 Corinthians 10:13, John 20:23 and Matthew 18:18.
