### New Scandinavia Lutheran Church Council Minutes November 11, 2025

**Non-Council members/visitors** – Dave & Louise Driver, the hard drive on the video PC is nearly full. It has 4.5 years of church services that he will remove, and will free up a lot of space. Louise discussed the "Gift Away" program that we did 3 years ago. Dave reinvested the funds in CD's and as a result, we now have another \$30,000 to gift to charities that will be approved by a select committee. They proposed that we present funds to the selected charities at worship service on February 15 and host a meal. **M/S/C** by Robert/Sue to participate in the Gift Away program, donate \$27,000 to the program, \$1,000 to cover the meal expenses, and balance to the General Fund.

Christmas program is scheduled for Dec 21<sup>st</sup> and practice will take place on Sundays in Dec. ## **GIVING MISSION CAMPAIGN**

## **APPLICATIONS DUE JANUARY 31, 2026**

When we received the money from the insurance company from the fire, there was lots of discussion as to how to spend it. When the building was rebuilt, we had \$250,000 left. Dave Driver took the responsibility to invest the money wisely. It was put in the Mission Investment fund at the ELCA which was paying the most interest. The CD's, which were 6 years, are now coming due. The interest on these CD's is about \$56,000.

At the time of the building much discussion centered around giving some of the money to the Glory of God. It was decided at that time that we would use the interest for that work. This is money we did not plan for, nor did we earn it. It was a gift.

The council voted to give ½ away in this program and the next half will be invested and given away in 3 years. The second 3 years have now passed, we have extra money for missions without touching the principle. The council has taken into consideration that a furnace could break etc. but they feel that \$250,000 would cover any such need.

We would like to have people pick up the application at the back of the church or the one in the newsletter and apply for grants for their missions. We would like to give priority to missions that people give to or work with within the church. You would be allowed to apply for more than one. Ex: quilting \$500... and maybe school kits \$500.00. Apply for what you need, and we will adjust the amount given as to how many requests come in.

A committee of 5 would then review all the requests and make the awards.

We would like to accept applications in December and January. With the cutoff date being January 31. The money would then be awarded in a special dinner with a representative from the organization receiving the money present to give a little overview as to how the money would be used. Some publicity will be done to promote the fact that our church is working for the Glory of God.

The awards and a celebratory meal will be held on February 15, 2026, after church.

Individuals that people have been working with are also included to receive the money should there be cancer etc. for need.
